

# HISTORIC JAPAN

10 DAYS/8 NIGHTS

► Tokyo, Hakone, Nagoya, Takayama, Shirakawago  
Gokayama, Kanazawa, Kyoto, Nara

**Day 1, Monday - Los Angeles/Tokyo**

Depart the USA on your Singapore Airlines trans-Pacific flight for Tokyo. Cross the International Date Line en route.

**Day 2, Tuesday - Tokyo**

Arrive at Narita Airport and transfer to your hotel. (Shiba Park/Keio Plaza)

**Day 3, Wednesday - Tokyo**

Full-day excursion includes a panoramic view of the city from atop Tokyo Tower, a tea ceremony, a Japanese-style lunch, a boat ride up the Sumida River, and visits to the Imperial Palace Plaza and the Asakusa Kannon Temple. (B/L)

**Day 4, Thursday - Tokyo**

A full day to explore the city on your own, or to join optional tours. (B)

**Day 5, Friday - Tokyo/Hakone**

Depart via motorcoach for a scenic drive up the slope of Mt. Fuji. Take a cruise on azure Lake Ashi, and stay overnight in the Hakone hot springs resort area. (Yumoto Fujiya) (B/L)

**Day 6, Saturday - Hakone/Takayama**

Bullet train to Nagoya, and then into the Japanese Alps and charming Takayama, so-called "Little Kyoto." This after-

noon, visit the Kusakabe Folkcraft Museum and the traditional wooden houses of old Kami Sannomachi Town. (Hida Plaza) (B)

**Day 7, Sunday - Takayama/Kanazawa**

After a visit to the morning market, depart along a scenic route to Shirakawago, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its historic significance. Visit the Folk Museum and unique "joined hands" farmhouse, and then learn to make paper by hand in Gokayama. Continue to Kanazawa. (Kanazawa/Nikko) (B/L)

**Day 8, Monday - Kanazawa/Kyoto**

Morning tour includes Kenrokuen Garden, created over the

span of several hundred years and one of the three most famous gardens in Japan, a Kutaniyaki pottery kiln, and the Nagamachi district, known for its historic samurai-class homes. Afternoon, train to Kyoto. (Karasuma/Okura) (B)

**Day 9, Tuesday - Kyoto**

Morning city tour to Golden Pavilion, Nijojo Castle, and Imperial Palace. Afternoon excursion by motorcoach to ancient capital of Nara to visit Todaiji Temple, Kasuga Shrine, and Deer Park. (B/L)

**Day 10, Wednesday - Kyoto/Los Angeles**

Transfer via train to airport for flight to Los Angeles. (B)

► Tokyo, Kyoto

**Day 1 - Los Angeles/Tokyo**

Depart Los Angeles via Singapore Airlines trans-Pacific flight to Tokyo. Cross International Date Line en route.

**Day 2 - Tokyo**

Arrive at Tokyo Narita International Airport in the late afternoon. After clearing immigration and customs, board airport bus with coupon to transfer to Shiba Park Hotel in Tokyo.

**Day 3 - Tokyo**

Highlights of today's morning city tour include famed Meiji Shrine, the Imperial Palace Plaza, and the old town shopping district of Asakusa and Ginza. Tour disbands in Ginza. Balance of the day at leisure. (B)

**Day 4 - Tokyo**

Free time to explore one of the world's largest and most vibrant cities. (B)

**Day 5 - Tokyo/Kyoto**

In the morning transfer from hotel to the railway station and travel from Tokyo to Kyoto by bullet train. In the afternoon, visit the splendid Heian Jingu Shrine, the ancient Temple of Sanjusangendo and Kiyomizu Temple. (Karasuma) (B)

Bus transfer to Osaka to a flight to Narita Airport. Connect with Singapore Airlines flight back to Los Angeles. Arrive home the same day. (B)
