

FASCINATING MYANMAR



Day 1 - Los Angeles/Bangkok

Depart the USA on your Singapore Airlines trans-Pacific flight for Bangkok. Cross the International Date Line.

Day 2 - Bangkok

Upon arrival in Bangkok you are transferred to your hotel. (Century Park/Avani Riverside)

Day 3 - Bangkok

After a morning of leisure, an afternoon city tour includes the Temple of the Golden Buddha, Marble Temple, and the colossal Reclining Buddha at Wat Po. (B)

Day 4 - Bangkok/Yangon

Fly to Yangon (Rangoon), the capital city of Myanmar (formerly known as Burma). Upon arrival transfer to your hotel. Afternoon sightseeing includes a sunset visit to the 2,500-year-old Shwe Dagon Pagoda and its 325-foot central

stupa sheathed in gold. (Chatrium/Sule Shangri-La) (B)

Day 5 - Yangon

Full-day tour includes Sule Pagoda, Botataung Pagoda, Kyauktagyi Pagoda, and National Museum. (B/L)

Day 6 - Yangon/Mandalay

Fly this morning to Mandalay, home of the largest marble Buddha in the world and center for Burmese art, architecture and handicrafts. Transfer to hotel. (Hilton) (B/L/D)

Day 7 - Mandalay

Excursion to the outlying environs of Mandalay. Visit Sagaing with its 600 monasteries, stupas, pagodas and temple caves on the hills nearby. (B/L/D)

Day 8 - Mandalay/Bagan

Fly this morning to Bagan, the city of 13,000 temples. Visit some of the most important temples and pagodas, including Bupaya Pagoda for a panoramic view over the Ayeryarwady River. (Tharabar Gate/Bagan Lodge) (B/L/D)

Day 9 - Bagan/Heho/Kalaw

This morning's activities include a stop at the colorful Nyaung Oo Market. In the early afternoon, fly to Heho. Then drive overland to Kalaw, a summer resort set amidst a pine forest. Check in to your hotel. (Amara Resort) (B/L/D)

Day 10 - Kalaw/Pindaya/Taunggyi/Inle Lake

Journey to Taunggyi, en route viewing the more than 6,000

Day 11 - Inle Lake/Yangon

A morning boat trip on the lake passes the floating gardens and provides a look at the lake's famous "leg-rowers." Return flight from Heho to Yangon. (Chatrium/Sule Shangri-La) (B/L/D)

Day 12 - Yangon/USA

Fly Singapore Airlines back to the US and arrive home the same day. (B)

Day 6 - Yangon

Transfer to airport for your departure flight. (B)

MYANMAR ADVENTURE

Day 1 - Yangor

Arrive in Yangon in Burma (now called Myanmar), and transfer to your hotel. Afternoon tour includes a sunset visit to the 2,500-year-old Shwe Dagon Pagoda and its 325-foot central stupa sheathed in gold. (Chatrium/Sule Shangri-La/Governor's Residence)

Day 2 - Yangon/Mandalay

Early morning flight to Mandalay. Full-day sightseeing in Mandalay, home of the largest marble Buddha in the world and center for Burmese art, architecture and handicrafts. (Hilton/Hilton/Rupar Mandalar) (B/L/D)

Day 3 - Mandalay/Bagan

Morning flight to Bagan, the city of 13,000 temples.

Full-day sightseeing includes a memorable experience at Bupaya Pagoda for a panoramic view over the Ayeryarwady River and the many ancient monuments that make this one of the richest archaeological sites in Asia. (Tharabar Gate/Bagan Lodge/Aureum Palace) (B/L/D)

Day 4 - Bagan

Continue touring Bagan and its surroundings. Take an overland excursion to sacred Mt. Popa, an extinct volcano. Now crowned with shrines at the peak, it is 777 stairs up from the base. (B/L/D)

Day 5 - Bagan/Yangon

Return to Yangon by air. More sightseeing in Yangon. (Chatrium/Sule Shangri-La/Governor's Residence) (B/L)
