

TIBET ADVENTURE

10 DAYS/8 NIGHTS

▶ Chengdu, Lhasa, Gyangtze, Xigaze, Hong Kong

Day 1 - USA/Chengdu

Depart the USA on your Cathay Pacific trans-Pacific flight to Chengdu. Cross the International Date Line.

Day 2 - Chengdu

Arrive Chengdu and transfer to your hotel. (Jinjiang)

Day 3 - Chengdu/Lhasa

Fly to Lhasa, the capital of Tibet. (Lhasa) (B/L/D)

Day 4 - Lhasa

Visit Potala Palace, Jokhang Temple, Sera Monastery, Norbulingka Park and the Drepung Monastery. (B/L/D)

Day 5 - Lhasa/Gyangtze

Travel 150 miles by motor coach/car to Gyangtze. Visit the Kumbun Stupa, which has 10,000 Buddha figures. (Gyangtze) (B/L/D)

Day 6 - Gyangtze/Xigaze

A two-hour drive takes you to Xigaze, the second largest city in Tibet. Here, you tour the Tashilhunpo Monastery, the seat of the Panchen Lama. (Xigaze) (B/L/D)

Day 7 - Xigaze/Lhasa

Return to Lhasa on a route that follows the Yarlung Zangbo River and the gorge that cuts through the mountains. (Lhasa) (B/L/D)

Day 8 - Lhasa/Chengdu

Join our extension to Nepal (page 9) or take a morning flight to Chengdu. Afternoon sightseeing in this capital of Sichuan, China's most populous province. (Jinjiang) (B/L)

Day 9 - Chengdu/Hong Kong

Transfer to the airport for the flight to Xian and our China Extension, or to Kunming and "South of the Clouds" (page 9), or fly to Hong Kong. (Harbour Grand) (B/L)

Day 10 - Hong Kong/USA

Board your Cathay Pacific flight for the USA. Arrive home the same day. (B)

This trip can be taken from Beijing to Lhasa (1 night in Beijing, and no stop in Chengdu) via the Qinghai-Tibet railway. Approximately 44 hours, the 2,500-mile scenic journey offers magnificent views of China's towering mountain passes and the great rivers, prairies and gorges of the beautiful Qinghai-Tibet Plateau, known as the roof of the world. Package rates are the same.



CHINA EXTENSION

Day 9 - Chengdu/Xian

Fly to Xian, China's great ancient capital at the eastern end of the fabled Silk Road. Upon arrival, you are met and transferred to your hotel. Afternoon sightseeing includes the Big Wild Goose Pagoda and the Bell Tower. (Sheraton) (B/L)

Day 10 - Xiai

The highlight of a visit to Xian is a trip to the excavation of the 6,000 life-size terra-cotta warriors and horses guarding the tomb of the Emperor Qinshi Huangdi. Stop at Hua Qing Hot Springs en route. Tonight enjoy a feast of delicate dumplings. (B/L/D)

Day 11 - Xian/Beijing

Travel by air to Beijing, capital of the People's Republic of China, where you are met by guides and transferred to your hotel. (Jianguo Garden) (B/L)

Day 12 - Beijing

A full-day sightseeing reveals the wonders of this 3,000-year-old city. Highlights include the monumental Tian An Men Square, the expansive courtyards and ceremonial halls of Forbidden City, the dazzling Temple of Heaven and the Summer Palace, where the emperors escaped the city's intense heat. (B/L)

Day 13 - Beijing

A full-day tour takes you to the magnificent Great Wall with a stop at the impressive Ming Tombs. This evening, enjoy a Peking Duck dinner. (B/L/D) 6 DAYS/5 NIGHTS

Xian, Beijing, Hong Kong

Day 14 - Beijing/Hong Kong

Fly to Hong Kong and transfer to your hotel. (Harbour Grand) (B)

Day 15 - Hong Kong/USA

After breakfast at your hotel, transfer to the airport for your return flight via Cathay Pacific to the US. Arrive home the same day. (B)
